In this regard, the Bill may provide that LegCo Member(s) to be appointed to the Board are to be elected by and from among LegCo Members. For those Board members from the professional sectors, the Bill may provide for an election mechanism linked to the relevant subsectors represented on the Chief Executive Election Committee. For those Board members from the arts and cultural sectors, the Bill may provide for an election mechanism linked to the Sports, Performing Arts, Culture and Publication functional constituency of LegCo.</p> <p>Will the Administration consider including relevant provisions in the Bill to the effect that the six-year six-board rule will be applicable to WKCDA Board members?</p>	CB(1)1119/07-08(01) It is practically difficult to specify in the Bill the full range of backgrounds and qualities required of Board members, but suggestions from members may be considered. 24.4.2008	Apart from disclosing upon their first appointment and on an annual basis, WKCDA Board members should also be required to disclose interest whenever there are changes in the circumstances of their interest. Disclosure of interest by WKCDA Board members should be made available on the Internet for inspection by the public.	CB(1)1465/07-08(02) Will consider amending clause 34 such that a WKCDA Board or committee member would be required to declare interest every year within the first month of each calendar year and whenever there is any change to the interest disclosed previously
