I. Meeting with the Administration

<u>The Bills Committee</u> deliberated (index of proceedings at **Annex**).

Definition of "requisition"

- 2. <u>Ms Audrey EU</u> said that the word "person" in the words "at the disposal of the person requisitioning it" and in the words "taking possession of it by the person requisitioning it", referred to in the definition of "requisition" set out in LC Paper No. CB(2)1573/07-08(02) prepared by the Administration, should be replaced by either "Government" or "authority", as the requisitioning of property during a public health emergency would invariably be made by the Government. <u>The Administration</u> agreed to consider and revert in writing.
- 3. At the request of Dr Joseph LEE, <u>the Administration</u> undertook to provide information on the definition of "requisition" in other local legislation.

Scrutiny of the draft provisions of the Prevention and Control of Disease Regulation

Section C1 - Power of entry and examination

4. <u>Ms Margaret NG</u> pointed out that a premises, other than a residential premises, such as a laboratory, might have a separate household unit used wholly or principally for dwelling purposes. To enable any health officer to carry out his duty under section C1, <u>Ms NG</u> suggested revising subsection (4) to empower the magistrate to issue a warrant authorising any health officer to enter or break into any premises. <u>The Administration</u> agreed to consider and revert in writing.

- 5. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded members that the next meeting had been scheduled for 18 April 2008 at 8:30 am to continue scrutiny of the draft provisions of the Prevention and Control of Disease Regulation commencing from section C6.
