**Report of the Subcommittee to Study Issues Relating to the
Provision of Boarding Places, Senior Secondary Education and
Employment Opportunities for Students with Special Educational Needs**

Purpose

This paper invites Members to note the Report of the Subcommittee to Study Issues Relating to the Provision of Boarding Places, Senior Secondary Education and Employment Opportunities for Students with Special Educational Needs (the Subcommittee), and seeks the agreement of the House Committee to allocate a debate slot under House Rule 14A(h) to the Chairman of the Subcommittee to move a motion on the Report at the Council meeting on 25 June 2008.

The Report

2. The Subcommittee was appointed by the House Committee in January 2005. Over the past three years, it had held 28 meetings to discuss with the Administration and receive the views of 73 organizations and 20 individuals on the various issues under study. The Subcommittee has summarized its discussions and drawn up 46 recommendations to improve the provision of education and related services for students with special educational needs.

Motion debate

3. At the meeting on 28 May 2008, the Subcommittee endorsed its Report for presentation to the House Committee on 6 June 2008. In view of public concern about the provision of education and related services for students with special educational needs, the Subcommittee considers that an opportunity should be provided for Members to express their views on the subject and for the Administration to provide its response. Members have agreed that a motion on the Subcommittee's Report should be moved for debate at the

Council meeting on 25 June 2008, and the agreement of the House Committee should be sought for the allocation of a debate slot to Dr Fernando CHEUNG Chiu-hung, Chairman of the Subcommittee, under Rule 14A(h) of the House Rules for moving the motion. Should the House Committee accede to the request, the debate slot will not be counted as the mover's own slot. The wording of the motion, as endorsed by the Subcommittee, is in the **Appendix**. Should the House Committee agree to the proposed debate on the Subcommittee's Report, the Subcommittee suggests that there should only be one other motion debate with no legislative effect at that Council meeting.

Advice sought

4. The House Committee's agreement is sought for the Subcommittee's request in paragraph 3 above.
