- (b) review the drafting of section 4 of the new Third Schedule to the Building (Planning) Regulations; and
- (c) provide the background and rationale for introducing the obligatory design requirements governing the provision of facilities to allow access to food premises, premises with auditorium, hotels and carparks by persons with a disability to tie in with the Design Manual Barrier Free Access 1997.
