2. Upgrade of Film/TV Production and Post-production Equipment in the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts	13.7.2007	The Administration was suggested that it should conduct a comprehensive review of the demand for local talents for the purpose of enhancing the development of creative industries, particularly film industry, and plan for the provision of adequate degree courses for training up the required creative talents, and provide a paper on the review to the relevant Panel.	The Home Affairs Bureau will be conducting a comprehensive manpower mapping survey on the need for arts and arts-related professionals in 2008 with a view to identifying any gaps between demand and supply and working out the necessary training provision in the light of the findings of the survey. This subject will be further reported in the Administration's submission to the Panel on the strengthening of the software and humanware for culture and the arts.'
