

**L.N. 201 of 2008****ANTIQUITIES AND MONUMENTS (DECLARATION OF HISTORICAL BUILDINGS) (NO. 2) NOTICE 2008**

(Made by the Secretary for Development under section 3(1) of the Antiquities and Monuments Ordinance (Cap. 53) after consultation with the Antiquities Advisory Board and with the approval of the Chief Executive)

**1. Declaration of historical buildings**

The buildings and the adjoining land situated within the Inland Lot No. 7327, No. 45 Stubbs Road, Hong Kong as delineated and shown edged red on the plan marked Plan No. HKM8358 signed and deposited in the Land Registry under section 3(4) of the Ordinance by the Secretary for Development, together with all structures erected on such lot, are declared to be historical buildings.
