To Whom It May Concern,

I'm very sure we have come to knowing that over a thousand people are standing at your doorstep claiming that what you are considering as to put homosexuality in front of family is completely contradictory to what we think as "conducting preventive countermeasures".

Many people looked forward to a new Hong Kong, one that would seem like a resolution to all the problems of Hong Kong's past, but now, if you put that literal tick on the box where it says legalize homosexual marriage, you will bring up new problems. Ones such as the people outside the council, people giving Hong Kong less imports due to the fact that they know we support homos, and soon homosexuality will spread like communism did. We have to be the outcasts and do what is right, not what others desire. As the Government, you have to have discipline.

Hong Kong is well known for its good reputation in high level education. Family means, a sustainable group consisting of members of parents and their children, considered as a group, whether dwelling together or not. A couple of the same age and gender do not produce offspring and are NOT physically a family. Sustaining a family is obviously a good thing, so kudos to you for making that policy. But family does not include homos who can't stand up for themselves and stick with an opposite gender instead of the normal male and female combination. You just have to know one thing, and it's very simple. Once a person gets to choose what policy he wants to govern his circle, he'll take it over the top, and that's what happened to Hitler.
