As you might be aware that in the discussions on the captioned bill, questions have been raised by different members including myself that the definition of a couple of " two persons " might still generate the possibility that more than two persons (say , three or five) may claim to fall under the said definition of " a couple " by making different applications of injunctions to the court, which, I believe, is not the legislative intent of the captioned bill .

To minimize the ambiguity of the definition, may I suggest to amend the definition to " a couple of two persons to the exclusion of others "? By adding " to the exclusion of others ", in my view, would clarify the position and minimize the ambiguity in the future.

I need your assistance a.s.a.p. in order to prepare for a private amendment to the captioned bill.
