**Follow-up to Meeting on 5 June 2009**  
**Cycle Tracks connecting North West NT with North East NT**


We refer to your letter referenced CB 1/F/1/10 of 8 June 2009 to the Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury.

In considering the paper referenced PWSC(2009-10)27 on the above subject, Hon IP Wai-ming enquired about the possibility of using the proposed cycle tracks for promoting cycling tourism and whether there were other initiatives for promoting cycling tourism in Hong Kong. We have consulted the Tourism Commission and would like to reply as follows.

The proposed cycle tracks connecting North West NT with North East NT and the ancillary facilities will certainly help promote cycling to the general public. There are connections to scenic spots and heritage sites along the proposed cycle tracks. We consider that promotion should initially focus on the local market, such as developing themed tours for local residents. When the market for cycling tourism becomes more mature and popular, promotion of cycling tours or activities to overseas visitors can be stepped up.

The Hong Kong Tourism Board (HKTB) has been working closely with the travel trade to develop new tourism products. Following the introduction of the cycling guided tour around the Deep Bay and Mai Po areas under the Nature Kaleidoscope Programme last November, the HKTB will work with the tour operator concerned to review the feedback from visitors and identify ways of further enhancing the product.
