Circumstances under which the Equal Opportunities Commission (EOC) may provide legal assistance for a case	16 February 2009	EOC was requested to provide information on - (a) criteria considered by EOC to provide legal assistance for a case; (b) whether EOC would consider providing legal assistance for a case if complainants had refused to settle disputes by conciliation in the first place; (c) number of cases where legal assistance was provided by EOC, the overall successful rate, and the litigation costs involved; and (d) financial arrangement for funding litigation cases.
