I Election of Chairman

Ir Dr Raymond HO, the member who had the highest precedence in the Council among members of the Subcommittee, presided over the election of Chairman of the Subcommittee. He invited nominations for the chairmanship.

Election of Chairman

2. Mr IP Kwok-him nominated Prof Patrick LAU and the nomination was seconded by Mrs Sophie LEUNG. Prof Patrick LAU accepted the nomination. Ms Cyd HO nominated Miss Tanya CHAN and the nomination was seconded by Mr KAM Nai-wai. Miss Tanya CHAN accepted the nomination. As there were two nominations, members cast their votes by secret ballot. Prof Patrick LAU received eight votes and Miss Tanya CHAN received six votes. Ir Dr Raymond HO declared that Prof Patrick LAU was elected Chairman of the Subcommittee. Prof Patrick LAU then took over the chair.

Election of Deputy Chairman

3. The Chairman solicited members' views on the need for a Deputy Chairman. At the suggestion of Ms Cyd HO and with the agreement of members, the Chairman invited nominations for the deputy chairmanship. Ms Emily LAU nominated Miss Tanya CHAN and the nomination was seconded by Ms Cyd HO. Miss Tanya CHAN accepted the nomination. There being no other nomination, the Chairman declared that Miss Tanya CHAN was elected Deputy Chairman of the Subcommittee.

5. Members agreed that the Subcommittee would hold its next meeting

before the harbour tour tentatively scheduled for 17 January 2009. The Administration would be requested to provide relevant information on the harbourfront areas, such as the locations of existing promenades and sites where it would be difficult to carry out harbourfront enhancement works.
