**Follow-up to the Development Panel
Special Meeting on 3 February 2009**

At the special meeting of the Development Panel held on 3 February 2009, the Administration undertook to provide further information regarding HKSAR's reconstruction support work in Sichuan. Our response regarding the configuration of the 303 Provincial Road, monitoring of HKSAR's reconstruction support projects, the number of site visits organized to Sichuan, and the number of Hong Kong professionals and overseas experts participating in those site visits is set out in our letter dated 19 February 2009 to you. Our response regarding the estimated costs of similar reconstruction projects in Sichuan is set out below for Members' reference.

Schools and hospitals are two major categories of reconstruction projects undertaken by the HKSAR Government. In the first and second stages, we have undertaken to reconstruct 57 schools and 30 hospitals. The scale and estimated costs of these projects vary depending on the particular circumstances of individual projects. For instance, the estimated costs for the 57 schools range from Renminbi 5.68 million to 77.37 million, and the planned

construction areas range from 1,784 m² to 47,185 m². In the case of hospitals, the estimated costs range from RMB4.82 million to 224.52 million, and the planned construction areas range from 1,800m² to 27,000m².

Subsequent to the Panel meeting on 3 February, we have requested the Sichuan Provincial Government to provide relevant information on similar projects in Sichuan. The information given by the Sichuan Provincial Government for reference regarding some of the outstanding planned school and hospital reconstruction projects in Sichuan is attached at **the Annex**. On a related note, many of the projects undertaken by other provinces are implemented through direct provision of materials and services, such as construction materials as well as professional planning, design construction and construction teams. The implementation method is quite different from projects funded by the HKSAR Government.

It would be difficult to draw a direct comparison between the two sets of projects since the nature, scale, design, location, functional requirements and facilities of individual reconstruction projects may differ. As such, the above information should be taken for general reference only.
