**Panel on Home Affairs
Conversion of Yau Ma Tei Theatre and Red Brick Building
into a Xiqu Activity Centre**

Further to our progress report of relocating the public toilet (PT), refuse collection point (RCP) and street sleepers' shelter (SSS) adjacent to Yau Ma Tei Theatre to the Panel on Home Affairs dated 4 May 2009, I append below the latest development of the relocation.

The Administration has identified potential sites for relocating the RCP and SSS and will conduct a technical feasibility study and consult the Yau Tsim Mong District Council on the project. The construction timetable will be confirmed subject to the result of the technical feasibility study, the views of the Yau Tsim Mong District Council, Town Planning Board's endorsement, if required and availability of fund. Separately, the Administration is exploring the possibility of relocating the PT in consultation with various stakeholders.
