The HKITJC highly concerns the latest business development of HKIRC and urge the Panel to address the following important issues:

1. HKIRC should open up their membership. Today, a .hk registrant is not automatically a HKIRC member and he/she has to formally apply to become one. Since the HK Internet space belongs to all .hk users, this practically deprives users' rights, e.g. company's voting right. This situation should be rectified.
2. The register/registrar model has been proposed for at least a year. But no concrete transition plan has been publicized. Suggestion: HKIRC provides a concrete roadmap.
3. Little has been known about HKIRC's plan in support IPv6 DNS.
