RE OBJECTION TO EXTEND THE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE ORDINANCE  
CHAPTER 189 TO COVER PERSONS OF THE SAME SEX AND LIVING  
TOGETHER (the “Extension”)

I strongly object any violence. I support that proper amendments be made to the  
Domestic Violence Ordinance Chapter 189 (the “Ordinance”).

I strongly object the extension of the Ordinance to cover persons of the same sex and  
living together as a family. The extension is NOT SCIENTIFIC, absolutely  
inconsistent with the Ordinance.

**The basic Ordinance covers persons who are DNA-related, and/or adopted  
-DNA-related.**

The Ordinance intends to give protection against potential violence amongst “family  
members” who are **DNA-related, and/or adopted- DNA-related**, and is desirable  
because of the inherent significant personal differences (especially physical strength)  
between family members living together.

PERSONS OF THE SAME SEX AND LIVING TOGETHER are not **DNA-related,  
and/or adopted DNA-related**. Protection for PERSONS OF THE SAME SEX AND  
LIVING TOGETHER are adequately covered similarly to “**PERSONS OF  
OPPOSITE SEX AND LIVING TOGETHER**” in existing ordinances.
