LegCo Delegation to Visit Pearl River Delta Region Tomorrow

The President of the Legislative Council, Hon Jasper TSANG Yok-sing, will lead members of the Panel on Economic Development and the Panel on Environmental Affairs to conduct a duty visit to Shenzhen, Guangzhou, Nansha and Zhuhai from tomorrow (May 15) to next Monday (May 18).

The visit was arranged upon receiving an invitation by the Guangdong authorities. The President believed that the visit will enable LegCo Members to gain a better understanding of the economic development and environment protection efforts in the Pearl River Delta area, and facilitate communication and cooperation between Members and the Guangdong authorities.

During the visit, the delegation will tour around facilities in the Guangdong Province related to logistics, tourism and environmental protection, including logistics centre, port and airport facilities, household waste incineration and power generation facilities, wetland park and the landing site of the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge.

The delegation will also meet with officials of the Guangdong Provincial Government, Shenzhen Tourism Bureau and Hong Kong entrepreneurs running business in the Mainland to discuss issues of mutual concern.
