The name of the Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Post-service Employment of the Civil Servants ("ACPE") before the Hon Mr Justice Pang Kin-kee and his term of office.</p> <p><i>CSB's Response: The Advisory Committee on Post-retirement Employment (the Advisory Committee) was first established in October 1987. It was renamed as ACPE in January 2006. The predecessor of the Hon Mr Justice Pang Kin-kee was the Hon Mr Justice Arthur Leong. His term of office as Chairman was from 7 October 1998 to 13 July 2003.</i></p>	
<p>2. The number of post-service work applications from directorate civil servants which ACPE had considered during the tenure of the Chairman in item 1 above and of these applications, the number which were considered: (a) by way of circulation to members of ACPE; and (b) by way of discussion at meetings of ACPE.</p> <p><i>CSB's Response: During the tenure of the Hon Mr Justice Arthur Leong as Chairman, the Advisory Committee had considered a total of 222 applications. All of them, except for two applications, were considered by way of circulation. The two cases were discussed at two separate meetings.</i></p>
