1.	<p>The Select Committee notes from paragraph 13 of Civil Service Bureau (CSB) Circular No. 10/2005 that no minimum sanitization periods are specified for directorate officers on agreement terms and those who have resigned from the Government, and the need for and length of the sanitization period for these officers is considered on a case by case basis. The Select Committee has asked for information on the post-service work applications submitted by directorate officers who have left the government on grounds other than retirement in 2007, 2008, 2009 and 2010 (up to end of May 2010), and the number of these applications approved by the Secretary for the Civil Service. Please provide a breakdown on the applications in each of the above years as follows:</p>
