The information in THB 132 and the enclosed documents show that New World Development Company Limited ("NWDC") was an indirect shareholder of FSDCL through its 51%-shareholding in New World Services Limited ("NWSL"). NWSL held 100% of the shares of Wealth March Property Limited ("WMPL"), which ultimately held 49% of the shares of FSDCL.
