Transport and Housing Bureau ("THB")'s response: Given the large amount of information involved, we need more time to compile our response. We will endeavour to provide the requested information to the Select Committee as soon as practicable.

(b) please advise whether the documents and records stated in (a) above show that Mr CHUNG Kwok-cheong was/is handling the case on behalf of Cheung, Chan & Chung, Solicitors and Notaries;

(e) please advise whether Mr LEUNG Chin-man had made any declaration of interest in respect of the disposal of the Hunghom Peninsula PSPS development during the period from November 2002 to December 2004 regarding (i) his personal relationship with Mr CHUNG Kwok-cheong; and (ii) his relationship with Cheung, Chan & Chung, Solicitors and Notaries by virtue of his personal relationship with Mr CHUNG Kwok-cheong, a senior consultant of the firm, and if so, the date and details.

THB's response: There is no file record to suggest that Mr LEUNG had made any declaration of interest in respect of the disposal of the Hunghom Peninsula PSPS development as PSH/DoH or a member of HA or its committees.

# 2. Please advise/provide -

(a) the functions of the Commercial Properties Committee ("CPC") of HA and the normal process for nomination of members to CPC;

THB's response: The functions of the CPC during Mr CHUNG Kwok-cheong's 2-year tenure as a CPC member (i.e. from 2003 to 2004 and from 2004 to 2005) are attached at THB 282 which are identical for the two years.

In nominating members of HA's committees (including CPC), inputs are obtained from Home Affairs Bureau ("HAB") and the senior directorates. The nominations would be submitted to the Chairman of Housing Authority and the Bureau Secretary responsible for housing matter for agreement. Each appointment is made on the basis of the merits of the individual concerned, taking into account the candidate's ability, expertise, experience, integrity and commitment to public service. A presumption paper would then be issued to seek the approval of the members of HA of the proposed membership of committees.

(b) a summary on the appointment of Mr CHUNG Kwok-cheong as a member of CPC including the person/party who made the nomination, the vetting process taken in the appointment, the term of the appointment, whether the nomination process in (a) above had been duly followed, and if not, the reasons;

THB's response: The process described in the response to 2(a) above has been applied to the nomination of Mr CHUNG. However, there is no file record showing the person/party who proposed his nomination. HA's approval was obtained for the appointment of members to the committees. (see THB 283 for the presumption paper issued to seek the approval of the members of the HA). Mr CHUNG was appointed as a member of CPC with effect from 1 April 2003 and he resigned upon expiry of his term on 31 March 2005.

(f) whether Mr CHUNG had attended any meetings of HA and/its committees where matters relating to the disposal of the Hunghom Peninsula PSPS development were discussed, and if so, details of the meetings.

THB's response: As regards CPC, during Mr CHUNG's tenure as a CPC member, the CPC did not have any meeting on the disposal of the Hunghom Peninsula PSPS development and did not issue any paper on the subject.

As regards HA meetings, although Mr CHUNG is not an HA member, he would have access to open papers available for public inspection online. During Mr CHUNG's tenure. there were three HA open papers on the subject issued. A copy of these papers are attached at THB 287 (which encloses a copy of IHB 6), THB 288 (which encloses a copy of THB 7) and THB 289 (which encloses a copy of THB 63). Besides, the subject has been raised at the HA annual special open meeting held on 10 June 2004 by one of the HA members in his speech. The notes of meeting is attached at THB 290, paragraph 4 of page 18 (Chinese version) and paragraph 2 of page 25 (English version) of the document Mr CHUNG attended the meeting as an are relevant. Attendee in his capacity as a CPC member. Apart from these open papers, no paper on the subject was issued to Mr CHUNG since he had declared his interests vide THB-286. TIR9(C)
