1. Declaration of historical buildings

The buildings, including the two buildings respectively known as the Old Green Island Lighthouse and the New Green Island Lighthouse, and the adjoining land, situated on Green Island, Hong Kong and within the area as delineated and shown edged red on the plan marked Plan No. HKM7691a signed and deposited in the Land Registry under section 3(4) of the Ordinance by the Secretary for Development, are declared to be historical buildings.
