

**L.N. 277 of 2008****ADMISSION AND REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) RULES 2008**

(Made by the Chief Justice under section 72 of the Legal Practitioners Ordinance (Cap. 159))

**1. Commencement**

These Rules shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the President of The Law Society of Hong Kong by notice published in the Gazette.

**2. Forms**

The Schedule to the Admission and Registration Rules (Cap. 159 sub. leg. B) is amended—

- (a) in Form 2, in paragraph (2)(aa), by repealing “attended” and substituting “completed”;
- (b) in Form 4, in paragraph 10 of part (a) of the declaration, by repealing “attended” and substituting “completed”.

**Explanatory Note**

These Rules amend the Admission and Registration Rules (Cap. 159 sub. leg. B) (“the principal Rules”) to introduce changes in line with the amendments made to the Legal Practitioners (Risk Management Education) Rules (Cap. 159 sub. leg. Z) (“the Risk Management Rules”).

2. Under the Legal Practitioners (Risk Management Education) (Amendment) Rules 2008 (L.N. 278 of 2008), the definition of “RME course” in section 2(1) of the Risk Management Rules is amended to include activities that are conducted, authorized or approved by The Law Society of Hong Kong. Therefore, certain references in the principal Rules covering certain RME courses have to be consequentially amended.
