

**Bills Committee on Road Traffic (Amendment) Bill 2010**

**List of follow-up actions arising from the discussion  
at the meeting on 4 November 2010**

The Administration was requested to:

- (a) advise on the definition of "grievous bodily harm", with reference to court cases under the common law;
- (b) provide information on the Government's prosecution policy on dangerous driving offences;
- (c) consider whether the offence of dangerous driving causing grievous bodily harm (DDCGBH) could be limited to circumstances of drink driving and drug driving only;
- (d) consider imposing a different imprisonment term under summary conviction for DDCGBH to tie in with the three-tier penalty system so as to reflect the difference in seriousness of the dangerous driving causing death, DDCGBH and dangerous driving offences; and
- (e) provide all proposed Committee Stage Amendments to the Bill for members' consideration.
