PART I EMPLOYEES RETRAINING ORDINANCE

Employees Retraining Ordinance (Cap. 423)

Employees Retraining Ordinance (Amendment of Schedule 2) (No. 2) Notice 2010 (L.N. 76)

Schedule 2 to the Employees Retraining Ordinance (Cap. 423) (the Ordinance) specifies the training bodies that may provide or conduct retraining courses for the purposes of the Ordinance.

2. By this Notice made by the Employees Retraining Board under section 31(2) of the Ordinance, Schedule 2 to the Ordinance is amended to delete one organization, and to reflect the change of the English and Chinese names of two organizations and the change of the Chinese name of one organization.

PART II COMMENCEMENT NOTICE

Import and Export Ordinance (Cap. 60)

Import and Export (Strategic Commodities) Regulations (Amendment of Schedules 1 and 2) Order 2010 (L.N. 45 of 2010)

Import and Export (Strategic Commodities) Regulations (Amendment of Schedules 1 and 2) Order 2010 (Commencement) Notice (L.N. 77)

3. The Import and Export (Strategic Commodities) Regulations (Amendment of Schedules 1 and 2) Order 2010 (L.N. 45 of 2010) (the Amendment Order) was made by the Director-General of Trade and Industry under section 6B of the Import and Export Ordinance (Cap. 60) to reflect the latest changes in the

international non-proliferation regime control list for certain strategic commodities as well as to relax the control over transit and air-transshipment of information security products. The Amendment Order was published in the Gazette on 30 April 2010 and was considered by the House Committee at its meeting on 7 May 2010. Members did not raise any queries on the Amendment Order.

4. This Notice appoints 14 June 2010 as the day on which the Amendment Order comes into operation.

5. The above items of subsidiary legislation have not been discussed by the relevant Panels. No difficulties in relation to the legal and drafting aspects of the above items of subsidiary legislation have been identified.
