# Legislative Council Subcommittee on Package of Proposals for the Methods for Selecting the Chief Executive and for Forming the Legislative Council in 2012

#### Follow up to the meeting on 11 May 2010

At the Subcommittee meeting on 11 May 2010, Hon. Ronny Tong requested the HKSAR Government to provide information on the seat-to-population ratio of overseas legislatures. The reply of the HKSAR Government is as follows.

The information requested by Hon. Tong is provided in the <u>Annex</u>. At present, the seat-to-population ratio of the Legislative Council (LegCo) is about 1:116800. We propose that the number of seats in the LegCo be increased to 70. The seat-to-population ratio will then be reduced to about 1:103000. Compared with overseas legislatures, we consider this ratio to be appropriate.

Singapore, Hong Kong and Republic of Korea adopt a unicameral legislature. For other countries which adopt a bicameral legislature, we compare the number of seats in their lower houses with their population.

The current term German Bundestag has a total of 622 members.

The US House of Representatives has a total of 435 seats, which are largely allocated on the basis of population. Seats in the US Senate are not allocated on the basis of population, but on the basis of states.
