Second report of the HKSAR under the International Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination	15 June 2009 (CA Panel)	The Administration was requested to - (a) provide information on the party responsible and the mechanism for handling complaints about discrimination against new arrivals from the Mainland; (b) provide information on the Administration's policy on combating discrimination against new arrivals from the Mainland; (c) explain why the recruitment policy of the civil service required a person to be proficient in both English and Chinese; and (d) explain why some post holders in the civil service were exempted from the Chinese language proficiency requirement.
