**Follow-up to meeting on 8 February 2010**

**Subsidised Residential Care Services for Persons with Disabilities**

At the meeting of the Legislative Council (LegCo) Panel on Welfare Services on 8 February 2010, the Hon. CHEUNG Kwok-che requested the Administration to provide information on the waitlisting situation for each type of subsidised residential care services for persons with disabilities(PWDs), the number of additional places by types of services to be provided in the two new Integrated Rehabilitation Services Centres (IRSCs) in Kwai Chung and Ho Man Tin, and a breakdown of additional residential places coming on stream by service types, together with their district distribution. The relevant information is set out in the following tables for Members' reference -

**(1) Provision of places, number of applicants on waiting list and average waiting time of various types of subsidised residential care homes for PWDs**
