


### From "As Made version" to "Consolidated version"

- (3) Sections 3, 4 and 6 come into operation on 8 August 2016.




### **Certification by the Law Draftsman ("LD")**

- LD can only certify consolidated versions of an Ordinance
- Purpose: to certify that the act of incorporation of amendments has been done correctly and thus the public could rely on that consolidated version for evidentiary purposes (i.e. "authorised copy" of an Ordinance)



The "authorised version" is highlighted for easy reference.



- The past consolidated versions of an Ordinance (i.e. from 30 June 1997 to the cut-off date) will be migrated from BLIS to the Database for information only.




