Chief Executive Election and Election Committee (EC) Election

Subject Matter	Government Proposal	CP CSA
For the 4 th sector of the EC, as a transitional provision for 2012, 10 "Special Member" seats will be created to make up the difference of 10 seats before the number of LegCo seats increases to 70 in October 2012.	10 "special member" seats to be allocated as follows: 4 seats : CPPCC 2 seats : HYK 2 seats : HK & Kln DCs 2 seats : NT DCs	Allocate all 10 seats to elected DC members.
The current election method of DC seats of EC election is by "bloc vote"	Retain "bloc vote system".	Adopt the "multiple seats, single vote" election method, each elector can only cast one vote, and candidates who receive the greatest numbers of votes are returned.
The number of EC members will be increased from 800 to 1200.	Increase the number of new members of each of the 4 sectors of the EC by 100 within each sector to increase the number of members in proportion to the <u>existing distribution</u> .	Increase the number of members in each of 4 sectors proportionately to the <u>size of their electorate</u> .(see the attached table)
Present nomination threshold is 100 subscribers from the total 800 EC membership.	Raise nomination threshold to not less than 150 subscribers from the total 1200 EC membership with no upper limit to be set;	Set upper limit of nomination at 165 subscribers i.e. 110% of Government's proposed threshold.
CE must not have any political affiliation.	Maintain restriction.	Remove restriction.

Subject Matter	Government Proposal	CP CSA
5 new DC functional constituency seats are created for 2012.	The 5 new DC FC seats will be returned by one single territory-wide constituency on the proportional representation list system.	Each of the existing 5 geographical constituencies to return 1 member by the single seat, single vote system.
Candidature	Elected DC members only.	Enlarge eligibility to all persons closely linked with DC, including all DC electors.
Who can nominate	Elected DC members only.	As above.
Existing DC FC --- DC (first) FC		
Subject Matter	Government Proposal	CP CSA
The electoral method for the existing DC FC seat.	To remain unchanged, i.e. to be elected by DC members from among themselves on a single seat, single vote system.	The single seat, single vote system.
Candidature	Elected DC members only.	Enlarging eligibility to all those who are closely linked with DC, i.e. all DC electors.
Who can nominate	Elected DC members only.	As above.

Traditional FCs		
Subject Matter	Government Proposal	CP CSA
Corporate voters in existing FCs	No amendment.	Abolish corporate votes, and substitute with: (a) directors of the company as voters, or (b) all practitioners/members of the FCs, i.e. the Nine New FC's proposal*
Nomination of FC candidates by corporate entities.	No amendment.	Abolish corporate nominations, and substitute: (a) directors of the company, or (b) all practitioners/members of the FCs, i.e. the Nine New FC's proposal**

* All members of the industry are eligible to register as electors.

** All registered electors are eligible to nominate candidate.
