### **Members' Motions**

#### Motion of Thanks

The President stated that Hon Albert HO, Hon LEE Wing-tat, Hon WONG Sing-chi, Hon Frederick FUNG and Hon Ronny TONG intended to move amendments to the motion. Also, Hon Cyd HO would move an amendment to Hon Ronny TONG's amendment. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendments would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Miriam LAU moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council thanks the Chief Executive for his address.

Question on the motion proposed.

The President announced the commencement of the first debate session on the theme of "Developing the Infrastructure for Economic Growth". The session covered the following policy areas: commerce and industry; development (planning, lands and works); economic development (other than energy); financial affairs; housing; information technology and broadcasting (other than creative industry); and transport.

A Member spoke.



Hon LAU Wong-fat declared that he was a landowner in the New Territories. He then spoke on the motion.

Another Member spoke.

The President said that Members' speeches should be confined to the policy areas specified for a particular debate session. Such arrangement, which had been agreed to by the Council and the Administration, sought to achieve a more focused debate in each session and facilitate the relevant public officers to immediately respond to Members' views in the respective debate session.

The President further said that Members failing to confine their speeches to the policy areas specified for a particular debate session was not in contravention of the Rules of Procedure. Hence, he would not stop Members from speaking on the ground that their speeches were outside the scope of the specified policy areas. However, under the circumstances, the relevant public officers might not be able to respond to Members' views in the respective debate session.

Hon Frederick FUNG spoke.

While Hon Frederick FUNG was speaking, the President left the chair at 12:16 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Two more Members and Dr Hon LAM Tai-fai spoke.

At 1:09 pm, while Dr Hon LAM Tai-fai was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Nine other Members spoke.

Hon Andrew LEUNG spoke and declared that he was a member of the Board of Directors of the Hong Kong Mortgage Corporation Limited.

Four more Members spoke.

Hon LEE Cheuk-yan spoke and declared that he was a beneficiary of the Home Ownership Scheme.

Another Member and Hon Tanya CHAN spoke.

While Hon Tanya CHAN was speaking, the President left the chair at 6:03 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

One more Member spoke.

Dr Hon Priscilla LEUNG spoke and declared that she was the owner of a small property from which she received rental income. The increase in property prices had therefore benefited her.

Three other Members and Hon Albert CHAN spoke.

At 7:31 pm, while Hon Albert CHAN was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Four more Members spoke.

The President suspended the meeting at 9:09 pm.

The Council resumed at 9:00 am on 28 October 2010 to continue the first debate session of the Motion of Thanks.

Twelve Members spoke.

The Financial Secretary, the Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development, the Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury, the Secretary for Development, and the Secretary for Transport and Housing spoke.

While the Secretary for Transport and Housing was speaking, the President left the chair at 1:16 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

The Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs spoke.

The President's Deputy announced the end of the first debate session and the commencement of the second debate session on the theme of "Quality City and Quality Life". The session covered the following policy areas: development (other than planning, lands and works); economic development (energy); environmental affairs; food safety and environmental hygiene; home affairs (other than district administration and civic education); and information technology and broadcasting (creative industry).

Eight Members and Hon Andrew LEUNG spoke.

At 3:57 pm, while Hon Andrew LEUNG was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Twelve other Members spoke.

The Secretary for the Environment, the Secretary for Development, the Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development, the Secretary for Food and Health and the Secretary for Home Affairs spoke.

While the Secretary for Home Affairs was speaking, the President left the chair at 7:00 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

The President's Deputy announced the end of the second debate session and the commencement of the third debate session on the theme of "Investing for a Caring Society". The session covered the following policy areas: manpower; security (anti-drug policy); and welfare services (including social enterprise and family matters).

Eight Members and Hon CHEUNG Kwok-che spoke.

At 8:27 pm, while Hon CHEUNG Kwok-che was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Another Member spoke.

The President suspended the meeting at 9:02 pm.

\* \* \* \* \*

The Council resumed at 9:00 am on 29 October 2010 to continue the third debate session of the Motion of Thanks.

Five Members spoke.

The Secretary for Labour and Welfare, the Secretary for Home Affairs and the Secretary for Security spoke.

The President announced the end of the third debate session and the commencement of the fourth debate session on the theme of “Optimising our Demographic Structure and Attracting Talent”. The session covered the following policy areas: education; health services; and security (immigration policy).

Eight Members and Hon CHAN Kin-por spoke.

While Hon CHAN Kin-por was speaking, the President left the chair at 12:43 pm temporarily and the President’s Deputy, Hon Fred LI, took the chair.

Four other Members spoke.

The Secretary for Education, the Secretary for Food and Health, and the Secretary for Security spoke.

The President’s Deputy announced the end of the fourth debate session and the commencement of the fifth debate session on the theme of “Developing Democracy and Enhancing Governance”. The session covered the following policy areas: administration of justice and legal services; constitutional affairs; home affairs (district administration and civic education); public service; and security (other than immigration and anti-drug policies).

Twelve Members and Hon Paul TSE spoke.

At 3:55 pm, while Hon Paul TSE was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

The President reminded Members that under the agreed arrangement, the debate on the Motion of Thanks was divided into five different sessions each covering a group of policy areas. The purpose of this arrangement was to facilitate a more focused debate in each session. If Members chose to ignore the agreed arrangement and not to confine their speeches to the specified policy areas in the respective debate session, the purpose of such an arrangement would be defeated. Moreover, it would be unfair to those Members who had strictly followed the arrangement. The President invited Members to seriously consider whether the current mode of debate on the Motion of Thanks should continue to be adopted.

Five other Members and Hon TAM Yiu-chung spoke.

With the President's permission, Hon Audrey EU elucidated a point she had made earlier which she considered to be misunderstood by Hon TAM Yiu-chung.

The Chief Secretary for Administration, the Secretary for Justice, and the Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs spoke.

While the Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs was speaking, Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung stood up and asked the Secretary to elucidate his reply. The President reminded Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung that he had already used up his speaking time and it was the turn for public officers to reply. The President then ordered Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung to sit down and stop speaking.

The Secretary for Constitutional and Mainland Affairs continued to speak.

The Secretary for the Civil Service, the Secretary for Security and the Secretary for Home Affairs spoke.

Hon Miriam LAU spoke on the amendments.

Hon Albert HO moved the following amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion:

To add “, and demands the Government to completely abolish the appointed and ex-officio seats in District Councils in 2011” immediately before the full stop.

Question on Hon Albert HO's amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion proposed and put.

Hon Albert HO claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 29 were present, five were in favour of the amendment, 20 against it and four abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 29 were present, 16 were in favour of the amendment and 12 against it (voting record in **Appendix I**). Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, he declared that the amendment was negated.

Hon Miriam LAU rose to move the following motion without notice:

That in the event of further divisions in relation to the Motion of Thanks or amendments thereto, the Council do proceed to each of such divisions after the division bell has been rung for one minute.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Hon LEE Wing-tat moved the following amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion:

To add “, but expresses strong condemnation that the Policy Address fails to take on board the social consensus on resuming the Home Ownership Scheme ('HOS'), and urges the Government to expeditiously resume the construction of HOS flats, re-launch the Sale of Flats to Sitting Tenants Scheme, and re-examine the practice of allowing eligible white form applicants to purchase HOS flats without premium paid in the secondary market for HOS flats, with a view to helping needy persons acquire their homes” immediately before the full stop.

Question on Hon LEE Wing-tat's amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion proposed and put.

Hon LEE Wing-tat claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 49(5) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 29 were present, seven were in favour of the amendment, 17 against it and five abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 29 were present, 18 were in favour of the amendment, eight against it and two abstained (voting record in **Appendix II**). Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, he declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon WONG Sing-chi moved the following amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion:

To add “, but expresses regret at his failure to face up to the problem of disparity between the rich and the poor and make earnest efforts to alleviate poverty, and to help the socially disadvantaged” immediately before the full stop.

Question on Hon WONG Sing-chi's amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion proposed and put.

Hon WONG Sing-chi claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 49(5) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 29 were present, six were in favour of the amendment, 16 against it and seven abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 29 were present, 17 were in favour of the amendment, seven against it and four abstained (voting record in **Appendix III**). Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, he declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Frederick FUNG moved the following amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion:

To add “, but expresses deep regret that the Policy Address fails to put forward any effective strategies for resolving the problem of disparity between the rich and the poor, ignores the importance of formulating a stable and sustainable long-term housing policy and disregards the strong expectations of this Council and the general public about resuming the construction of Home Ownership Scheme flats” immediately before the full stop.

Question on Hon Frederick FUNG's amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion proposed and put.

Hon Frederick FUNG claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 49(5) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 29 were present, seven were in favour of the amendment, 17 against it and five abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 29 were present, 19 were in favour of the amendment, seven against it and two abstained (voting record in **Appendix IV**). Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, he declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Ronny TONG moved the following amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion:

To add “, and urges the Government to immediately commence work on enacting legislation in relation to the political reform in one go and seek a broad consensus, so that the SAR Government can, on this basis, expeditiously initiate the procedures of amending Annex I and Annex II to the Basic Law on the methods for selecting the Chief Executive and for forming the Legislative Council, thereby implementing genuine universal suffrage as promised in the Basic Law” immediately before the full stop.

Question on Hon Ronny TONG’s amendment to Hon Miriam LAU’s motion proposed.

Hon Cyd HO moved the following amendment to Hon Ronny TONG’s amendment:

To delete “immediately commence work on enacting legislation in relation to the political reform in one go and seek a broad consensus, so that the SAR Government can, on this basis, expeditiously initiate” before “the procedures” and substitute with “respect the aspiration of more than 500 000 electors in the ‘de facto referendum in five geographical constituencies’ on 16 May for demanding the implementation of dual universal suffrage in 2012, and to commence”; and to delete “genuine universal suffrage as promised in the Basic Law” immediately before the full stop and substitute with “universal and equal suffrage to eliminate the disparity between the rich and the poor caused by privileges and monopolies”.

Question on Hon Cyd HO’s amendment to Hon Ronny TONG’s amendment proposed and put.

Hon Cyd HO claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 49(5) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 29 were present, four were in favour of the amendment, 21 against it and four abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 28 were present, 15 were in favour of the amendment, 10 against it and two abstained (voting record in **Appendix V**). Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, he declared that the amendment was negatived.

Question on Hon Ronny TONG’s amendment to Hon Miriam LAU’s motion put.

Hon IP Kwok-him claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 49(5) of the Rules of Procedure.



The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 29 were present, four were in favour of the amendment, 20 against it and five abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 29 were present, 16 were in favour of the amendment, 10 against it and two abstained (voting record in **Appendix VI**). Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, he declared that the amendment was negated.

Hon Miriam LAU replied.

Question on the motion put.

Hon Albert CHAN claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 49(5) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 29 were present, 26 were in favour of the motion and three against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 29 were present, 10 were in favour of the motion and 18 against it (voting record in **Appendix VII**). Since the question was agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, he declared that the motion was negated.

### **Next meeting**

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 3 November 2010 at 11:00 am.

The Council was adjourned at 6:10 pm.
