In response to Ms HO's concern about the replacement after the coal-fired generation units at the Lamma Power Stations and its Extension would come to the end of their book lives in 2017 or 2018, the Administration advised that in that circumstances, the Hongkong Electric Co. Ltd. (HEC) would need to replace them with gas-fired units.</li> <li>Discussion on HEC's investment in power generation from nuclear energy and interconnection of the electricity grids between the two power companies if the fuel mix proposal of 50% nuclear energy, 40% natural gas and 10% coal and renewable energy was adopted for 2020.</li> </ul>	
001539 – 002253	Chairman Mr KAM Nai-wai Administration	<ul> <li>Mr KAM Nai-wai expressed the views that as it was not practicable for him to forecast the growth in electricity demand for 2015 and beyond, he therefore would not propose amendment to lower the emission allowances for the Lamma Power Station and its Extension under the Second TM.</li> <li>Discussion on emission trading between power companies in Hong Kong and Pearl River Delta Region, and the regional effort in reducing the emissions of the specified pollutants with a view to improving air quality.</li> </ul>
