An Ordinance to amend the Motor Vehicles (First Registration Tax) Ordinance to give effect to the proposal in the Budget introduced by the Government for the 2011–2012 financial year to raise the first registration tax for private cars.

[23 February 2011]

Enacted by the Legislative Council.

1. Short title and commencement

- (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (First Registration Tax) (Amendment) Ordinance 2011.
- (2) This Ordinance is deemed to have come into operation at 11 a.m. on 23 February 2011.
