# Nature of Contravention Cases (2010-2011) Under the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance

### Background

1. This paper aims to respond to Hon Ip Kwok-him's question raised in the meeting of the Legislative Council Panel on Constitutional Affairs on 16 May 2011 on the nature of contravention cases concluded by the Office of the Privacy Commissioner for Personal Data ("PCPD") under the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance ("the Ordinance") in 2010-11.

## Types of Data Users

2. Of the formal investigations PCPD completed in 2010-11, 28 cases were found in contravention of the requirements under the Ordinance. 21 cases involved private sector organizations, 6 cases involved public sector organizations (i.e. government departments and other public bodies), and the remaining 1 case involved individual.

#### Nature of Contraventions

- 3. The 28 cases in question involved a total of 38 contraventions (as one complaint case might contain more than one alleged contravention, the number of contraventions was greater than the number of cases), including:
  - (a) 1 contravention about "direct marketing" (i.e. data user continued to use the complainant's personal data in direct marketing despite the complainant's opt-out request);
  - (b) 6 contraventions about non-compliance with "Data Access Request"; and
  - (c) 31 contraventions about violation of Data Protection Principles ("**DPPs**").
