New Yau Ma Tei Public Cargo Working Area (PCWA)

1. As response to tender exercises for the allocation of berths indicates, the industry's demand for the PCWA remains robust. Moreover, in view of the busy operation of the PCWA, the Government has no plan to close or relocate it at present.

2. At present, members of the public may walk along Hoi Fai Road on the Tai Kok Tsui waterfront promenade to the roundabout located at the fringe of the PCWA (near its entrance), or enter the PCWA through its south end. No pedestrian access is available between the roundabout and portion of the south end of the PCWA. Subject to no adverse impact to the operations of the PCWA, the Administration in collaboration with the Harbourfront Commission can also explore the feasibility of enhancing existing or providing additional pedestrian access, including the proposed construction of a footbridge.

Harbourfront Commission

3. The Harbourfront Commission was set up in July 2010. It is a high-level non-statutory advisory body established to succeed the former Harbour-front Enhancement Committee in advising the Government on harbourfront planning, design, management and other related matters, with the objective of fostering and facilitating the development of the Victoria Harbourfront. The Commission comprises broad-based

representatives from various sectors of the community including professional institutes, civic and environmental groups, and the business sector. Besides, the presence of the Secretary for Development as the Vice-Chairperson to the Commission reflects the priority that the Administration accords to harbourfront enhancement. Government departments will work closely with the Harbourfront Commission to achieve the long-term vision for the creation of a vibrant, green, accessible and sustainable harbourfront.
