**Legislative Council Panel on Education**  
**List of outstanding items - Revitalizing vacant school premises**

Further to our letter dated 7 May 2010 to the Legislative Council Secretariat on the captioned matter, the latest position regarding the use and disposal of vacant school premises is set out below for Members' reference.

In view of the various requests made by members of the community for early identification and disposal of vacant school premises to meet educational and other community needs in recent years, we have, in the past year or so, stepped up our existing mechanism with a view to planning well ahead on the use of to-be-vacated premises so that they may be recycled as soon as possible after the school has ceased operation. Moreover, we have enhanced our liaison with various policy bureaux and departments concerned in order to facilitate early

identification of those premises that may not be required for educational use and hence could be released for other uses.

As a result, among those 37 school premises that have become vacant as at May 2011, 14 have already been deployed or re-allocated for further educational uses while 13 have been provisionally earmarked for further educational uses and for the latter, action is underway to put the premises into operation in accordance with the earmarked uses. The remaining 10 premises were found not suitable for educational purpose owing to their limited size and remote locations and have been returned to the relevant lands authorities for disposal. Details of these 37 school premises concerned have been provided in our reply of 25 May 2011 to Oral Question No. 6 raised by Hon Audrey Eu on "Places in international schools" as well as the supplementary information provided on 15 June 2011. Members may wish to refer to Annexes 1 to 4 for reference.

As an ongoing process, we shall closely liaise with departments concerned in order to arrange re-allocation of suitable vacant school premises for school and other educational uses where appropriate. We will also continue to step up our efforts in the disposal of vacant school premises as detailed above, with a view to facilitating parties concerned to put vacant school premises into gainful use in a timely manner.
