1. <u>Briefing by the Secretary for the Civil Service on the policy initiatives of the Civil Service Bureau featuring in the 2010-2011 Policy Address</u>	18.10.2010	<p>The Administration was requested to provide in the paper for the agenda item on "Employment of non-civil service contract (NCSC) staff" to be discussed at the Panel's November regular meeting the following –</p> <p>(a) The Administration's response to a member's concern that it was unfair and demoralizing that when NCSC staff could successfully apply for civil service posts, their periods of employment with the Government on contract terms were not taken into account for the provision of incremental credits, and that they would only receive pay at the starting salary point of the relevant ranks; and</p> <p>(b) The ratio of civil servants, NCSC staff and agency workers working in government departments, particularly the Buildings Department.</p>	The Administration's response is awaited.
2. <u>Supplementary provision arising from the modification to the '3+3' civil service entry system</u>	18.10.2010	The Administration was requested to report in late 2010 the results of its assessment of the suitability for permanent appointment of the officers who had opted for further appointment on new permanent terms.
