### Legislative Council Panel on Security Follow-up to Special Meeting on 8 April 2011

In respect of the follow-up enquiry by Hon WONG Ting-kwong on the subject of handling seized illicit cigarettes after the Special Meeting on 8 April 2011, the Administration's reply is set out below.

Under the Dutiable Commodities Ordinance (Cap. 109), seized illicit cigarettes will be forfeited by the Customs and Excise Department (C&ED) after an order of forfeiture is granted by the court or on the condition that no legal claim is made. Between 2002 and March 2011, C&ED has forfeited approximately a total of 986 million sticks of illicit cigarettes (Annex), of which 85% have been destroyed. The rest will be destroyed after relevant procedures on the cases involved have been completed.
