LegCo Panel on Manpower visits labor organizations in the Republic of Korea (with photos)

The Legislative Council (LegCo) Panel on Manpower continues its duty visit in the Republic of Korea today (July 27) and will meet with the Economic and Social Development Commission and Korean Confederation of Trade Unions to gain a better understanding of the implementation of standard working hours in the Republic of Korea.

On its second day of visit in Seoul yesterday (July 26), the delegation met with representatives from the Korea Labor Foundation, which is an influential tripartite organization in employment, labor as well as the enhancement of exchange and cooperation between Republic of Korea and the international community. With its board of directors comprising the heads of the Federation of Korean Trade Unions ("FKTU") and the Korea Employers Federation, as well as representatives of the Ministry of Employment and Labor and the Economic and Social Development Commission.

In the afternoon, the delegation met with the Korea Labor Institute a government-funded research institute, to understand the impact of the phased implementation of standard working hours on employers, employees and the society. The delegation also met with FKTU, the largest national federation of trade unions in the Republic of Korea, to learn about their views on the implementation of standard working hours in Korea.
