The Chief Executive's Question and Answer Session

The Chief Executive attended the Council meeting.

When the Chief Executive was about to address the Council, Hon Albert CHAN and Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung spoke aloud. The President asked them to keep quiet.

The Chief Executive addressed the Council.

A Member and Hon Emily LAU asked questions and the Chief Executive replied.

After the Chief Executive had replied to Hon Emily LAU's question, Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung made loud noises while he remained seated. The President reminded Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung that he would be ordered to withdraw from the Council if he continued to make loud noises while he remained seated.

Another Member asked a question and the Chief Executive replied.

Hon WONG Yuk-man asked a question. While Hon WONG Yuk-man was asking his question, the President asked him to stop making arguments. Hon WONG Yuk-man ignored the President's advice and continued to make arguments. The President ordered him to stop speaking and sit down, but Hon WONG Yuk-man ignored the President's order. After the President had again asked Hon WONG Yuk-man to sit down, some people in the public gallery yelled. The President asked them to keep quiet.

The Chief Executive replied to Hon WONG Yuk-man's question.

Six other Members and Hon Frederick FUNG asked questions and the Chief Executive replied.

While the Chief Executive was replying to Hon Frederick FUNG's supplementary question, Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung stood up and spoke on a remark made in the Chief Executive's reply to Hon Frederick FUNG's supplementary question. The President asked Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung to stop speaking and sit down. The Chief Executive continued to give his reply.

Another Member and Hon Albert CHAN asked questions and the Chief Executive replied.

After the Chief Executive had replied to Hon Albert CHAN's question, Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung stood up and yelled. The President ordered him to sit down. Ignoring the President's order, Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung kept standing and spoke aloud. The President then ordered Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung to immediately withdraw from the Council. While Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung was leaving the Chamber with the assistance of the Clerk and security staff,

Hon WONG Yuk-man stood up and yelled. The President ordered Hon WONG Yuk-man to immediately withdraw from the Council. While Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung and Hon WONG Yuk-man were leaving the Chamber with the assistance of the security staff, Hon Albert CHAN stood up and yelled. The President ordered Hon Albert CHAN to also withdraw from the Council immediately. Hon LEUNG Kwok-hung, Hon WONG Yuk-man and Hon Albert CHAN left the Chamber.

Two more Members asked questions and the Chief Executive replied.

The Council was adjourned at 4:34 pm.
