That this Council urges that: the 4 June incident be not forgotten and the 1989 pro-democracy movement be vindicated.

2. Motion as amended by Hon WONG Yuk-man

That this Council urges that: the 4 June ~~incident~~ *tragedy* be not forgotten ~~and,~~ *pro-democracy figures be released,* the 1989 pro-democracy movement be vindicated, *the responsibility for the massacre be ascertained, one-party dictatorship be ended and a democratic China be built.*
