We are unable to attend the meeting. Re the proposed Order exempts places that are under the management of The Legislative Council Commission from the operation of sections 4 and 11 of the Places of Public Entertainment Ordinance (Cap. 172) (*the Ordinance*) so that those places may be kept or used as places of public entertainment within the meaning of the Ordinance without any license granted under the Ordinance, Museum of Site would like to **endorse** the Ordinance and we propose **further exemption without condition could be offered to any individual or organization which offers public entertainment of various nature on a one-off or temporary basis without temporal license application or any license granted under the Ordinance in the said public places**, such that the cultural ambiance of the said public places can be enriched / enhanced through proposed event(s) without administrative obstacle. The reasoning behind the argument is to ensure that the amended order will not offend the general ordinance provision of free expression and enjoyment art and culture by individual artist, group or content-provider in public places.

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
