On the day of the event, the organizer of the performance concerned was advised by police officers at the scene on two occasions that their activity might require a Temporary Places of Public Entertainment Licence and they might commit an offence for carrying on the activity without such a licence. The organizer then of its own volition ceased the performance. The officers concerned acted in accordance with their normal practice and procedure in handling the subject incident.
- 4. As legal proceedings are underway, it is inappropriate for the Administration to provide any further information about the case or discuss the same in further detail.
