Introduction

To enhance the support services for ethnic minorities (EMs) and facilitate their early integration into the community, the District-based Integration Programme has been implemented in six districts, namely **Wan Chai, Yau Tsim Mong, Kwun Tong, Kwai Tsing, Tuen Mun and Yuen Long**, by the relevant District Offices in collaboration with district organisations and non-governmental organisations since April 2011. This leaflet provides information on the activities organised in the six districts under the Programme.

Project Title : Community Harmony for Ethnic Minorities in Wan Chai

Project Title : Youth Community Participation Scheme
Service Provider : Kwun Tong Integrated Children & Youth Service of Hong Kong Christian Service

Project Content :

- **"Discovering Kwun Tong"**
To enhance EM youths' knowledge and understanding of community culture and resources by organising visits to cultural spots as well as different organisations and groups in the district;
- **"Care in Kwun Tong"**
To foster the spirit of love and care among EM youths through a series of volunteer training and services in order to realise their potential in caring for the needy in the district, thus achieving participation in and contribution to the community; and
- **"Harmony@Kwun Tong"**
To increase local understanding of EM culture by creating a sharing platform through a variety of stalls and exhibitions, and to build harmonious neighbourhoods through more interaction and understanding.
