



#### Senior Citizen Residences Scheme (SEN) Concept Developed by Housing Society

#### Rationale

- Target customers being middle income (asset) elderly
- Government charging nominal land premium, but applicants subject to means tests
- Comprehensive one-stop care and medical supporting services
- Disposal by way of long lease (for life) on a balanced consideration of affordability, security of tenure and control of elderly residents to avoid abuse

#### Ultimate Objective

"Healthy Aging" and "Aging in Place"

# Joyous Living Scheme Another Choice for Financially Better Equipped Elderly



#### HS's New Elderly Housing Initiatives

- Reckoning that the pilot SEN Scheme has been well received, the Chief Executive's Policy Address in 2007 requested HS to continue the comprehensive home care approach by expanding the SEN scheme in HK Island.
- In 2008, the Government approved the development of 2 quality retirement housing projects proposed by HKHS at Tanner Hill, North Point and Wetland Park Road, Yuen Long.
- In 2010, surveys conducted by HS revealed needs of more affordable elderly for quality retirement housing.



# Joyous Living Scheme Development Model

- Land Grant at full market land premium for elderly flats and facilities (except GIC facilities)
- Flats for lease only [Long (life) lease and short lease]
- Age 60 or above (No means test)
- Quality retirement lifestyle to ensure happy, healthy living through one-stop services
- User-pays without Government subsidy for services and facilities






