**Select Committee to Study Mr LEUNG Chun-ying's  
Involvement as a Member of the Jury  
in the West Kowloon Reclamation Concept Plan Competition  
and Related Issues**

**Proposed work plan  
(as at 9 March 2012)**

**Purpose**

This paper invites members to consider the proposed work plan of the Select Committee to Study Mr LEUNG Chun-ying's Involvement as a Member of the Jury in the West Kowloon Reclamation Concept Plan Competition and Related Issues ("the Select Committee").

**Proposed work plan**

2. The proposed work plan of the Select Committee is formulated with reference to the work plans of the four previous Select Committees and the proposed areas of study of the Select Committee (LC Paper No. CB(2)1319/11-12(02)). Members may wish to conduct work in three main stages listed below.

Stage I - Preparatory work (conduct of meetings – about two weeks)

3. The main activities during this stage are:
- (a) to draw up and determine the practice and procedure for the Select Committee;
  - (b) to work out and decide on the areas of study;
  - (c) to decide on the information to be obtained from relevant parties

and analyze the relevant information; and

- (d) to identify the witnesses to be summonsed, decide on the order of the witnesses and the main areas of evidence to be obtained.

Stage II - Obtaining and deliberation on evidence from witnesses (conduct of hearings - about six weeks)

4. The main activities during this stage are to obtain evidence from witnesses in respect of the areas of study and to consider the evidence obtained. The duration of this stage may vary depending on the areas of study, the number of witnesses summonsed and the complexity of the issues involved.

Stage III – Preparation, discussion and finalization of the report (internal deliberations – about eight weeks)

5. The main activities during this stage are:

- (a) to deliberate on the evidence obtained;
- (b) to discuss the approach in drafting the report;
- (c) to prepare the draft report;
- (d) to discuss the draft report;
- (e) to seek the comments of any person(s)/organization(s) against whom adverse comments are intended to be made on the relevant parts of the draft report; and
- (f) to finalize the report.

6. It is proposed that the Select Committee will proceed as follows:

- (a) **from early March to mid March 2012** - to hold meetings for preparatory work;
- (b) **from mid March to late April 2012** - to conduct hearings to receive evidence from witnesses; and
- (c) **from late April to late June 2012** - depending on the progress of (b), to prepare the report, hold internal deliberations to discuss the draft report, and finalize the report with a view to tabling the

report at a Council meeting in late June 2012.

**Proposed frequency of meetings/hearings**

7. Subject to endorsement of the proposed work plan and in view of the tight work schedule, it is proposed that the Select Committee hold two meetings or hearings per week. If the meeting is a hearing, a pre-hearing and a post-hearing internal meeting, each lasting for 30 minutes, will be held.

**Advice sought**

8. Members are invited to endorse the proposed work plan in paragraphs 4 to 6 and the proposed frequency of meetings/hearings in paragraph 7 above.
