**Select Committee to Study Mr LEUNG Chun-ying's

**Purpose**

Members are invited to consider the witnesses to be invited to assist the Select Committee to Study Mr LEUNG Chun-ying's Involvement as a Member of the Jury in the West Kowloon Reclamation Plan Competition and Related Issues ("the Select Committee") in its study.

**Witnesses to give evidence or to produce documents**

2. The Select Committee may, subject to sections 13 and 14 of the Legislative Council (Powers and Privileges) Ordinance (Cap. 382), order any person to attend before it and to give evidence or to produce any paper, book, record or document in the possession or under the control of such person. According to the proposed Practice and Procedure of the Select Committee, the Select Committee may also request any person or body to attend a meeting to give evidence orally, invite any person or body to give evidence in writing or any person or body to produce specified documents to the Select Committee. The privileges and immunities provided in Cap. 382 are available in proceedings before the Select Committee which include hearings and deliberative meetings.

3. Based on the proposed major areas of study of the Select Committee [LC Paper No. CB(2)1319/11-12(02)] and the papers and documents on or relevant to the West Kowloon Reclamation Concept Plan Competition available to the Legislative Council, a list of persons who may assist the Select Committee in its study has been drawn up at the **Appendix**.

4. Subject to the decision of the Select Committee on the persons to be invited as witnesses, members may need to decide whether the proposed persons should be summoned to appear before the Select Committee to give evidence; and the order of the persons to be summoned or invited to give evidence.

**Advice sought**

5. Members are invited to consider -
- (a) the persons to be invited to assist the Select Committee in its study;
  - (b) whether the persons in (a) above should be summoned to appear before the Select Committee to give evidence; and
  - (c) the order of the persons to be summoned or invited to give evidence to the Select Committee.
