

L.N. 166 of 2011

Prisons (Amendment) Order 2011

(Made by the Secretary for Security under section 4 of the Prisons Ordinance (Cap. 234))

1. Commencement

This Order comes into operation on 20 January 2012.

2. Discontinuance of the use of places and buildings as prisons

The places and buildings specified in the Schedule are discontinued from use for the purposes of prisons.

3. Setting apart of Lai Chi Kok Reception Centre as a prison

The Lai Chi Kok Reception Centre (the place and buildings situated at 3/5 Butterfly Valley Road, Lai Chi Kok, Kowloon) is set apart for the purposes of a prison.

4. Prisons Order amended

The Prisons Order (Cap. 234 sub. leg. B) is amended as set out in section 5.

5. Schedule amended

(1) The Schedule—

Repeal the item relating to Lai Chi Kok Correctional Institution.

(2) The Schedule, item relating to Lai Chi Kok Reception Centre—
