I write to express my strong objection to the passing of the DSD laws in legco.
The implementation of the said stamp duty does not serve the purpose of controling an overheated property market, but leads to artificial suppression of property transaction volumes.

There are genuine buyers in $H K$ that would want to buy properties, whether commercial or residential, but are prohibited from doing so due to high purchase costs ie the DSD. This does not serve any purpose of cooling an overheated property market. It just kills transactions, but not prices.
