Public Works Subcommittee Follow-up Action on the Discussion at the Meeting Held on 5 February 2013

At the meeting of the Public Works Subcommittee on 5 February 2013, Members requested further information relating to PWP Item No. 111KA - Government, Institution or Community Facilities in the Kwun Tong Town Centre Redevelopment – Additional Medical and Health Facilities. I have pleasure in enclosing the information as below –

(a) There is one disabled toilet in the Occupational Health Clinic (OHC) in the new Kwun Tong Jockey Club Health Centre (KTJCHC). This is in accordance with the requirement under the relevant provision in the Building (Planning) Regulations that there should be one disabled toilet compartment provided on a floor if there are no more than 20 toilet compartments (male and female in total) on that same floor. According to the records of Labour Department, the majority of patients visiting OHC are workers with work-related illnesses, including musculoskeletal disorders, dermatitis, hearing disorders, etc. Only a very small number of the patients on wheel chair attend OHC for treatment. Therefore, no enhanced provision is considered necessary.

If the disabled toilet at the OHC is occupied, attending disabled patients can use the other disabled toilets in the KTJCHC, namely, at either the Hospital Authority's General Out-patient Clinic (GOPC) or the Department of Health's Maternal & Child Health Centre (MCHC) or Government Dental Clinic (GDC). There are three disabled toilets at the GOPC which is at the upper ground floor and two disabled toilets at the MCHC and the GDC which is at the lower ground floor;

- (b) The ratio of male to female toilet compartments in the OHC is approximately 1:1.5. This is an enhanced ratio from the requirement under the relevant Practice Notes issued by the Buildings Department at 1:1;
- (c) The breast-feeding room at the MCHC is located next to the Children Playing Area (please see the plan attached at the **Annex**). The Government developed the Advisory Guidelines on Babycare Facilities in August 2008 for reference by government departments and public organisations. According to these Guidelines, the breast-feeding room should be family-friendly. Supporting facilities in the breast-feeding room include sink with lever tap and soap dispenser, hot and cold water dispenser (for bottle-feeding), nappy changing table with raised edge and wipeable soft mat, breastfeeding chair and simple breast-feeding equipment; and
- (d) The ratio of male to female toilet compartments in the MCHC is approximately 1:5. This is an enhanced ratio from the requirement under the relevant Practice Notes issued by the Buildings Department at 1:1.


