23 June 2014 (Monday) 10:45am	Community Care Fund ("CCF") (including the CCF's policies to assist Comprehensive Social Security Assistance ("CSSA") recipients to save)	<p>Given that the Administration undertook to brief the Subcommittee on the work progress of the CCF every six months, and the last briefing was held in December 2013, the Administration intends to brief the Subcommittee in June 2014.</p> <p>The Deputy Chairman has proposed to discuss the CCF's policies to assist CSSA recipients to save. He has suggested that in addition to the Administration, deputations should also be invited to join the discussion of this item.</p>
